RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RESTORATION OF PUBLIC MOORINGS AT GODDARD STATE PARK

- WHEREAS, Greenwich Cove is a body of water shared by the Town of East Greenwich and City of Warwick; and
- WHEREAS, The Governor of the State of Rhode Island has called for improving recreation facilities at the State's parks; and
- WHEREAS, The Governor mentioned Goddard Memorial State Park in Warwick as a site where recreational facilities could be enhanced and improved; and
- WHEREAS, There were at one time four public moorings in front of Goddard Park Beach that transient boaters could use, but the moorings were removed about a decade ago; and
- WHEREAS, By reinstalling said moorings would not affect the existing East Greenwich mooring field; and
- WHEREAS, The East Greenwich Town Council joins with the Warwick City Council for the desire to have the moorings reinstalled because it would attract boaters from around the State to Goddard Memorial State Park as well as to the East Greenwich Waterfront and Main Street area; and
- WHEREAS, The cost to reinstall the moorings is low compared to the benefit that would be generated for people who want to visit and utilize the facilities not only at Goddard Memorial State Park but the nearby East Greenwich business establishments.
