Thank you for the support the Town of East Greenwich gives to the East Greenwich Chamber of Commerce. We feel that our working relationship greatly enhances the East Greenwich community and makes it one of the best in the State of Rhode Island.

Last year, the East Greenwich Chamber of Commerce asked the Town of east Greenwich for \$25,000 and we received \$20,500. This year, we are once again asking for \$25,000. Our Board of Directors and Staff feel very strongly that this has been earned and is a great investment for the Town of East Greenwich.

Several years ago, the Town earmarked \$18,500 in its budget for a Main Street Coordinator. When the Town dropped that amount and the position that went with it from its budget, the Chamber stepped up and took over the role. Not only did we pick up that responsibility, but we have grown the Strolls and increased the visibility of all of East Greenwich and Main Street. Our efforts have produced national and regional publicity which has included MSNBC (Your Business TV show), New England Boating TV show and Small Business Saturday promotional visits by the Rhode Island Foundation, Lt. Governor McKee, Congressman Langevin, Senator Reed, and the New England SBA. What's more, we started a very successful Restaurant Week which complements the very strong restaurant community that we help attract and support. All this restaurant activity contributes greatly to the meals tax for the Town. Our Welcome to East Greenwich (WTEG) book, which is a complete guide to the Town, is very important resource for the Town and the entire community. WTEG itself costs \$25,000 a year to produce.

Not only has the Chamber increased events and activity in East Greenwich, but our promotion of the Town as a destination and as a great place to live, work, play, dine and do business is ongoing. This is a great challenge given the retail climate and the relatively small base that the Chamber serves. We continue to be unique as one of the few stand-alone chambers in Rhode Island. This status gives us the unique ability to focus on East Greenwich and its economic development matters.

As we have indicated previously, we appreciate the Town's support, but we also feel that the \$25,000 request has been earned and is a great investment for the Town. Keeping in mind that \$18,500 was previously allocated by the Town, plus all the additional promotion that we have taken on, it should be evident as to how we are being stretched to be an important cog in the economic well-being of East Greenwich.

We appreciate all the previous support and hope that you will honor our request for 2019 as we feel it has been earned.

In our correspondence of February 19, 2019, the EG Chamber requested \$25,000 from the Town of East Greenwich to help us continue the quality of the promotion, events, and activities that benefit the entire community and help make East Greenwich a better place to live, work, play, dine, shop, and do business. We feel strongly that the East Greenwich Chamber has stepped into the role of being a de facto marketing, promotions and economic development arm for the Town of East Greenwich.

The East Greenwich Chamber of Commerce spends approximately \$52,000 per year promoting events and activities that benefit the Town of East Greenwich, its business community, and the overall quality of life in the community. The three activities below require many hours of boots on the ground efforts, electronic and social media marketing and promotion hours, plus various expenses including but not limited to, printing and signage. We also help raise money for charities and non-profits such as the London Bridge Project, Clothes to Kids RI, East Greenwich Little League, American Heart Association, Crossroads Homeless Shelter, RI Enlisted Association of the National Guard, and The Tomorrow Fund, among others. The Chamber's marketing efforts help in getting money to other non-profits in our community.

In the \$52,000, we have included nothing for overhead. The expenses we identified were all direct costs. We feel that the \$25,000 requested has been earned and is a great investment for the Town of East Greenwich.

The following is a breakdown with associated costs of the activity.

- The total cost of production, printing, and distribution of 5,000 Welcome to East Greenwich books (WTEG) is \$25,000. WTEG is a complete guide to the Town of East Greenwich and the community. This quality publication, which is 100 pages, includes information such as a telephone directory, town history, town government, town facilities and services, education, special housing, recreation, and youth activities and so much more.
 - WTEG has turned out to be an excellent promotional piece for the town and is used heavily by the real estate community in promoting East Greenwich as a place to relocate. The WTEG books are distributed to the public at the South County Tourism Center; the rest stop on Rt. 95 North upon entering Rhode Island; T.F. Green Airport; several Dave's Marketplaces; East Greenwich Town Hall; East Greenwich Free Library; and many other locations.
- 2. The total cost of a part-time Main Street Coordinator, plus direct advertising, marketing, print and production costs is \$16,000. In addition, the Chamber allocates a portion of its email advertising, website, and social media promotion of the Main Street Strolls and all activities on

Main Street such as the Holiday Parade and Christmas Tree Lighting, Trick-or-Treat on Main, Town of East Greenwich parades, and much more. The estimated allocation of these resources is \$5,000 per year. In total, we allocate \$21,000 for Main Street, its events, and overall promotion of East Greenwich.

Main Street advertising is seen by over 300,000 individuals through television, radio, print, and social media. The work and money we spend promotes all our Strolls, other Main Street events, as well as Main Street as a destination for shopping and dining.

These efforts have yielded national and regional publicity and recognition including MSNBC's *Your Business*; New England Boating television show on New England Sports Network; several media covered events on Main Street including Small Business Saturday visits by the New England Small Business Administration, Senator Reed, Congressman Langevin, The Rhode Island Foundation, and Lt. Governor McKee. Most recently, the Main Street Strolls received a Best in Rhode Island Award from RI Monthly for *Best Free Attraction on the West Bay*. We also received a citation from Governor Raimondo for this recognition.

3. East Greenwich Restaurant Week costs the Chamber approximately \$6,000 per year in labor (to organize and promote), media expenditures and printing costs. It has been a huge addition to the Chamber activities and is largely done to promote a vibrant restaurant community and showcase East Greenwich as a destination for people all over the state. Each September, we get over 20,000 individuals to visit our website and learn about East Greenwich Restaurant Week. We know these visitors are from all over Rhode Island and other parts of New England. Our efforts to promote our restaurant scene all year long (including publishing a restaurant guide), and our concentrated effort on Restaurant Week, no doubt are a significant contributor to the 1% meals tax collected by the Town of East Greenwich. As a strong indication of this, we note that the meals tax receipts for the Town of East Greenwich have continually increased year after year. As an example, the meals tax was \$587,000 in 2015. In 2019, it was to \$914,000.

We are confident that this memo provides detail as to the importance of our grant request of \$25,000 from the Town of East Greenwich. We believe it represents an important investment for the Town of East Greenwich. We thank you for your consideration.
