The Town of East Greenwich Town Council will hold a Public Hearing on May 20, 2019 at 7:00 PM in the Town Council Chambers of Town Hall, 125 Main Street, East Greenwich RI relative to amending the Town's Zoning Ordinance. Specifically Chapter 260, Zoning, of the Town Code. Article II "Definitions" – being Section 260-6 of the Code, "Terms Defined" shall be amended to address liquor distilleries which are currently not provided for in the Code. In addition, a corresponding change to "Attachment 1" of Chapter 260, Zoning, of the Town Code, Table 1: *Table of Permitted Uses by Zone* is proposed to allow the newly defined distillery types in some locations. Further, Chapter VI, "Off-Street Parking Regulations," namely Section 260-20 of the Zoning Code shall also be amended to establish a minimum on-site parking space requirement for distilleries.

The East Greenwich Planning Board is required to review this zoning amendment in advance of the Town Council's consideration and to forward its findings and a recommendation. They will meet in regular session at 7:00 PM on Wednesday May 1, 2019 in the Council Chambers of Town Hall, 125 Main Street to consider the draft Ordinance.

All interested persons are invited to attend the Public Hearings and be heard. Modifications to the proposal may occur as a result of the comments received during the hearing. The proposed changes can be reviewed in the Planning Department, 111 Peirce Street, Second Floor - during normal business hours.
