My insurance agent Matt Doorley (cc'd) from Doorley Agency, Inc. (<http://www.doorleyagency.com/>) suggested I contact you about the following.

My family and I recently (March 2017) moved to East Greenwich. Shortly after taking residence at 70 Kenyon Ave, on March 23rd, a town snow plow threw snow from the street and damaged my car and house fence/gate. The police report is attached.

My auto insurer (Travelers) submitted a successful subrogation claim, covered car repairs, and refunded my deductible.

My home insurer (UPC) covered fence/gate repairs, however, they were unwilling to pursue subrogation (letter attached) to refund my \$1,000 deductible.
