Whereas, Municipal Clerks have pledged to be ever mindful of their neutrality and impartiality, rendering equal service to all, and


Whereas, The Municipal Clerk serves as the information center on functions of local government and community, and




Whereas, it is appropriate that we recognize the accomplishments of the Office of the Municipal Clerk.


